Notes to the Precept Budget

Note 1: Clerk's Salary:

When the budget was set in January 2021 it was agreed the Clerk should be paid for five hours per week on the NALC SCP pay scale of 11, which then stood at £11.53 per hour, making a total salary 260 hours at £11.53 = £2,980.

In January 2022 the NALC pay scales were not available as the unions were still negotiating. Councillors therefore voted to increase the Clerk's salary by £200 p.a. to £3,180 p.a. After the Precept Budget had been set for 2022/2023 the NALC pay scales were published, and SPC 11 had been increased to £12.50 per hour, making a total salary for the year of £3,250, rather than £3180. The Clerk was therefore underpaid by £70. Rates for 2023/2024 are not available so the calculation in this budget utilized SCP 11 for 2022/2023, namely 260 hours @ £12.50 per hour - £3250.

Note 2 The council is to be charged £100 for the election work in July 2022. This can be paid from the balance available from Item 14 above.
