

Help with Transport – Good Neighbours

The Diddlebury Parish data gathered for the 2013 Parish Plan did not evidence any significant transport problems for parishioners but a small number of respondents did indicate interest in making use of a voluntary car scheme.

The Craven Arms Good Neighbours Scheme (supported by Shropshire Council) provides a number of volunteer services in the locality including assistance with transport to the doctors, dentist and hospital.

Good Neighbours is a group of local volunteers who give their time to help others in and around Craven Arms. They carry out tasks for people who need a little short term help, maybe through illness or infirmity or whose family is away or unavailable.

There is a modest charge for transport which is confirmed at time of booking.

However if you do own a car, have some free time, and would be prepared to help with volunteer driving then why not join the volunteers at Good Neighbours and help those who may have transport difficulties.
